Transplanter Type Hydromatic

Egedal Hydromatic is a newly developed transplanter.

The Egedal Hydromatic is constructed with a large diameter steel disc, mounted on a depth barrel. Behind this is the special share. The construction of the steel disc and planting share ensures optimum cutting and necessary depth of furrow. The independently suspended presser wheels create an effective firming and closing of the planting furrow under all conditions.

Egedal Hydromatic is equipped with specially designed planting arms which automatically place the plant into the furrow. The planting arm is equipped with grippers to hold the plant material. As soon as the plant is correctly placed into the furrow, the gripper automatically releases it. The presser wheels firm the plant in the furrow.

The machine is designed for one or two operators, who are seated on high back padded seats. The presentation of the planting arm, when ready to receive plant is such that it enables the operators to work in an upright and comfortable position.

The plant distance in the row is adjusted by means of an electric monitor. Selection of the desired plant space is made and the device will automatically activate the planting arm at the correct point. The monitor is also equipped with a plant counter.

Transplanter with great capacity for trans-planting conifers and hardwood trees in fields, in woods and in plantations.

Ergonomically correct working position with specially designed planting wheel.

Electronic setting of the planting distance.

Well qualified for all types of land areas.

Standard three-point hitch.
